

Equal Groups & Division

Division Equal Group Sentences

Multiplication:

8 taxis have 3 passengers in each. How many passengers are there altogether?

$$8 \times 3 = 24$$

Division by Sharing:

24 passengers must fit equally into 8 taxis. How many passengers go in each taxi?

$$24 \div 8 = 3$$

Division by Measuring / Grouping:

24 passengers travel 3 to a taxi. How many taxis are needed?

$$24 \div 3 = 8$$

Solve these now:

- 12 passengers must fit equally into 4 taxis. How many passengers go in each taxi?
- 18 passengers must fit equally into 6 taxis. How many passengers go in each taxi?
- 12 passengers travel 3 to a taxi. How many taxis are needed?
- 20 passengers travel 4 to a taxi. How many taxis are needed?
- 27 passengers travel 3 to a taxi. How many taxis are needed?
