

# Identifying the Ordinal Number

Identify the ordinal number for the last bird:

An ordinal number is a type of number that tells you the position of something in a list or sequence. For example, first, second, third, fourth, fifth, etc. are ordinal numbers. They tell you the order of things, but not the quantity.

You can think of ordinal numbers like a line-up. If you line up in a queue with your friends, you will be the first, your friend will be the second, another friend will be the third, and so on. These numbers tell you the order of people in the line-up.
