1. Ariana has 32 pencils. She shares them between her 5 friends. How many pencils will each of her friends get? How many pencils will Ariana have remaining?
2. Gabriel has \$1.50. He wants to buy a pencil box for everyone coming to his party. Each pencil box cost 20p. How many pencil box will he be able to buy? How much money will Gabriel have remaining?
3. Aunt Garcia has 100 balloons which she needs to share between 30 children at the fair. How many balloons does each child get? How many will be remaining with her?
4. Louise has 39 packets of cookies. She must share these equally between her 5 friends. How many cookies packets will each friend get? How many will Louise have remaining?
5. Grandpa buys 30 toy cars. He decides to share them between his 4 grandchildren. How many will each child get? How many will be left over?
6. There are 62 books on the shelf. They need to be shared equally amongst 10 table groups in the class. How many books will there be on each table? Will there be any left over?
