- 1. Susan had a meter of rope. She gave $\frac{1}{5}$ th to her sister and $\frac{2}{5}$ th to her brother for their craft activity. How much portion of the rope will be with Susan now?
- 2. A shopkeeper had 150 mobile phones. He sold $\frac{1}{3}$ rd of them in the first week. How many mobile phones will be left with him now?
- 3. Rebecca spent $\frac{1}{10}$ th of her pocket money of \$ 100 to buy fidget spinner, $\frac{2}{10}$ th on buying new books. How much did she spend on buying new books and how much will she be left with now?
- 4. Tom's father filled 50 gallons of petrol in his car. After driving for 3 days, he said 1/4th of the petrol is over. How many gallons of petrol is left in the car now?
- 5. Anne's mom gave her a box containing 30 chocolates. Anne gave $\frac{1}{6}$ th of the chocolates to Anna her friend and $\frac{2}{6}$ th to Frank her brother. How many chocolates did she give to Anna and Frank each? How many will be left with Anne now?
