

Converting Decimals to Percentage

$$0.38 =$$

Multiply 0.38 by 100

$$0.38 \times 100 = 38$$

Put the percent sign.

Answer: $0.38 = 38\%$

Easy way to multiply by 100 is to: move the decimal point 2 places to the right.

$$0.\underline{3}.\underline{8} = 38\%$$
