

Adverbs of Manner: It expresses HOW an action was done or is done
Example: - Susan dances WELL

Adverbs of time: It expresses WHEN an action was done or is done
Example: - Can you call me TOMORROW

Adverbs of Place: It expresses WHERE an action was done or is done
Example: - the children are AT SCHOOL

Adverbs of Frequency: It expresses HOW OFTEN an action was done or is done
Example: - Susan is always in time for her music class
