

Convert g to kg

To convert lb into gram you should multiply it by 453.

Example: $1 \text{ lb} = 1 \times 453 = 453 \text{ g}$

Remember: 1000 g is 1 kg

500 g is 0.5 kg

a. $1 \text{ lb} = \underline{453} \text{ g} = \underline{0.453} \text{ kg}$

b. $2 \text{ lb} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}} \text{ g} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}} \text{ kg}$

c. $8 \text{ lb} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}} \text{ g} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}} \text{ kg}$

d. $3 \text{ lb} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}} \text{ g} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}} \text{ kg}$

e. $5 \text{ lb} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}} \text{ g} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}} \text{ kg}$

f. $7 \text{ lb} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}} \text{ g} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}} \text{ kg}$
